

OWNERSHIP HISTORY OF RIVERSIDE CEMETERY

December 23, 1887

John Guild & Seth Bullock sold to George Fuller for \$500.00 the S1/2 of SE1/4 and S1/2 of SW1/4, Section 10, T8N, R2E, BHM, Butte County – 160 acres.

November 7, 1889

Pre-Exemption Patent issued to George Fuller by President Benjamin Harrison.

July 7, 1896

Sheriff's Deed issued to Western Dakota Loan & Trust Company (SW ¼, Section 10, T8N, R2E, BHM included in this sale).

June 2, 1900

Quick Claim Deed for \$100.00 issued to Bruce Sebastian, F. G. King, Lee Martin, John Brant, Tom Johnson, Samuel G. Mortimer, Dana Simmons, Clark Reeves, Joseph Dreskell, Joseph Highsaw and H. E. Thompson (SW ¼, Section 10, T8N, R2E, BHM included in this sale).

August 9, 1900

Warranty Deed issued to George B. Craft Trustee for \$3,500.00 (SW ¼, Section 10, T8N, R2E, BHM included in this sale).

August 25, 1900

George B. Craft Trustee sold to J. L. Hibbard Jr. for \$1,500.00 the SW1/4, Section 10, T8N, R2E, BHM and **2 acres set aside to Bruce Sebastian et al. for Cemetery.**

April 29, 1991

Quick Claim Deed for \$1.00 to George F. Mortimer & Dorothy Mortimer Dunlap, only children of Samuel G. Mortimer, from the City of Belle Fourche for the 2 acres containing the Riverside Cemetery.
