

**8.25.010 – Weeds and grass.**

- A. All weeds and plants declared to be dangerous or noxious weeds by the South Dakota Department of Agriculture or the State Weed Commission, and all other weeds that are declared noxious, dangerous or unhealthy vegetation are declared a public nuisance. It shall be the duty of all property owners and occupants within the City of Belle Fourche to cut such noxious vegetation at such time as necessary to prevent its growth.
- B. No landowner or occupant shall allow grass, weeds or noxious vegetation to grow to a height of more than eight (8) inches. All grass, weeds or noxious vegetation longer or higher than eight (8) inches is declared a nuisance. This section does not prohibit the cultivation of crops or vegetation grown in a field, livestock pasture, garden or undeveloped, unpopulated area.
